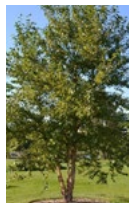
## Donations

Fringe Tree



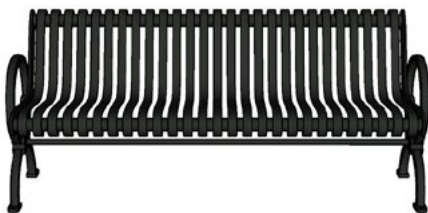

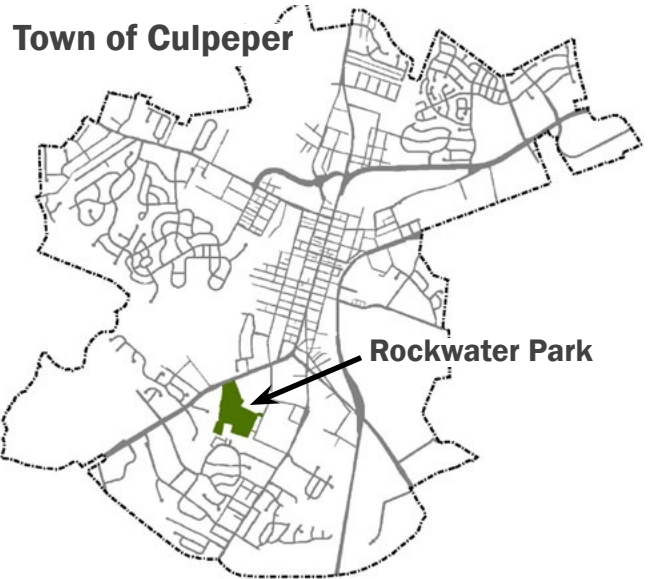

## About Rockwater Park

Opened in the Spring of 2018, Rockwater Park encompasses 32 acres of rolling hills and retired farmland that is located off Madison Road in-between the Southgate and Meadowbrook shopping centers. The park offers a mile of multi-use trails, public parking and bathrooms, a large pavilion, a disc golf course, a splash pad, an obstacle course, a bouldering rock, and a 40-yard dash! As the park grows and develops over time, the Rockwater Park Master Plan envisions a playground for young kids and additional pavilions. The Town is currently accepting donations/sponsorships for trees, benches, and dog litter bag disposal stations.
